Installation Instructions

If you wish to remove the rear bags from the camper door before fitting the table, please use the following steps:

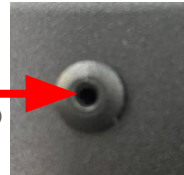


A. Locate the rivets that mount the bags to the inside of the rear door and drill them out from the outside of the door.



B. Place a small piece of sealant (preferably SikaFlex) on the black rivets supplied in the kit to plug up the holes made from drilling out the rivets.

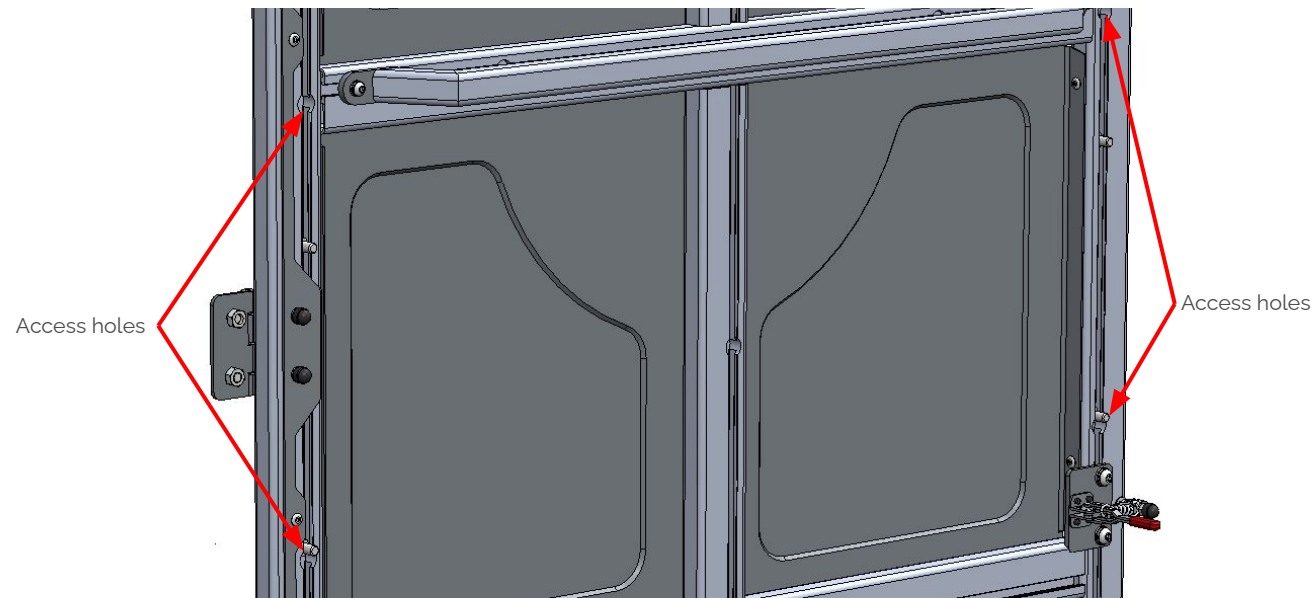
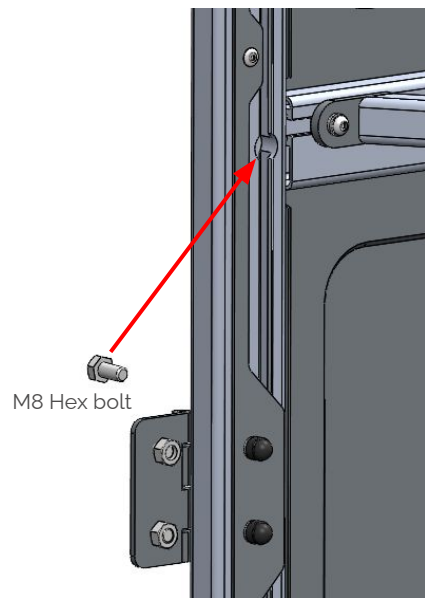
C. Place a small piece of sealant (preferably SikaFlex) on hole of the rivet

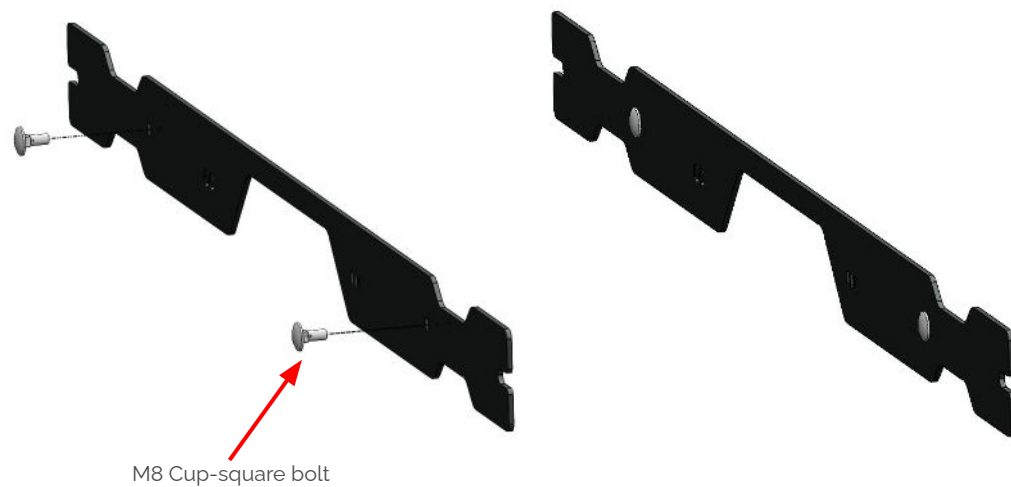

Place the 4 x M8 Hex bolts into the access holes and slide then down the extrusion



Installation Instructions

- 3.1 Place the M6 Cup Square bolts into the square holes in the brackets

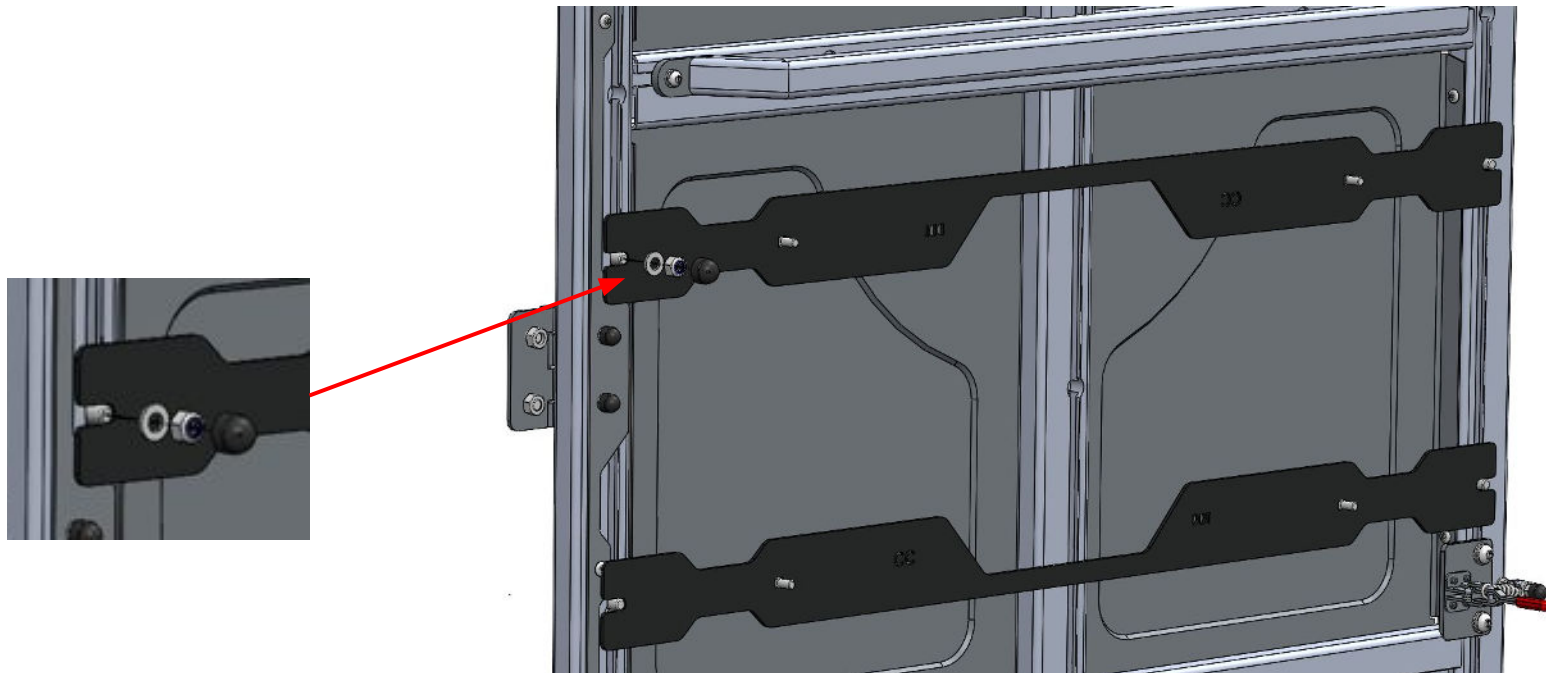


- 3.2 Secure the back of the bolts to the brackets using tape



Installation Instructions

- 4 Fasten the M8 Nylock nut and washer onto the M8 bolt allowing the bolt to slide in the extrusion.

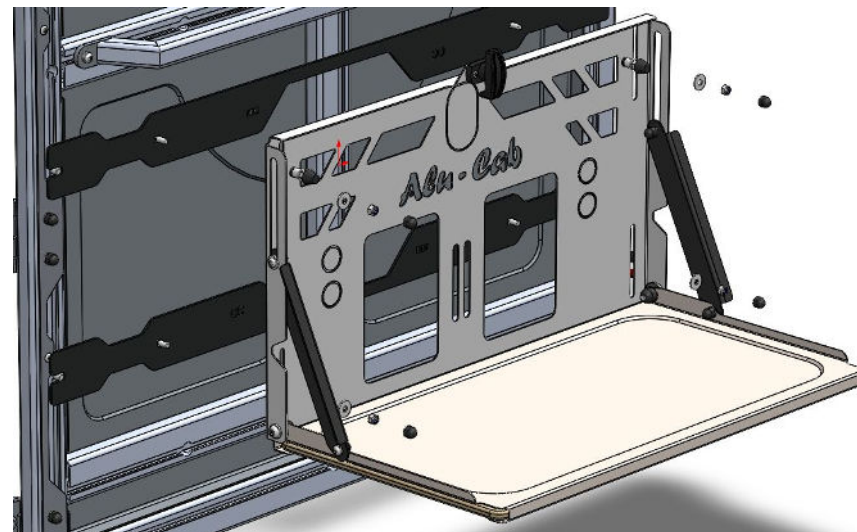
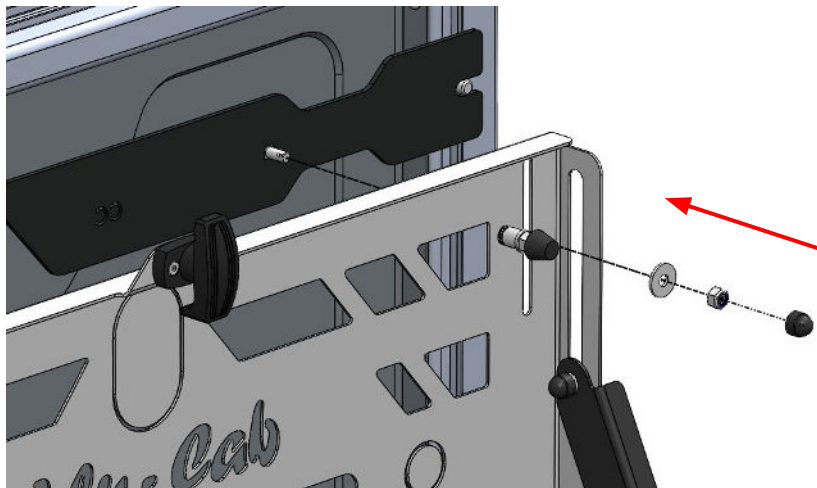


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Fasten the M6 washers and nyloc nuts to the cup square bolts and place the plastic nut-cap over the nut when tightened.

Congratulations, the table has been mounted





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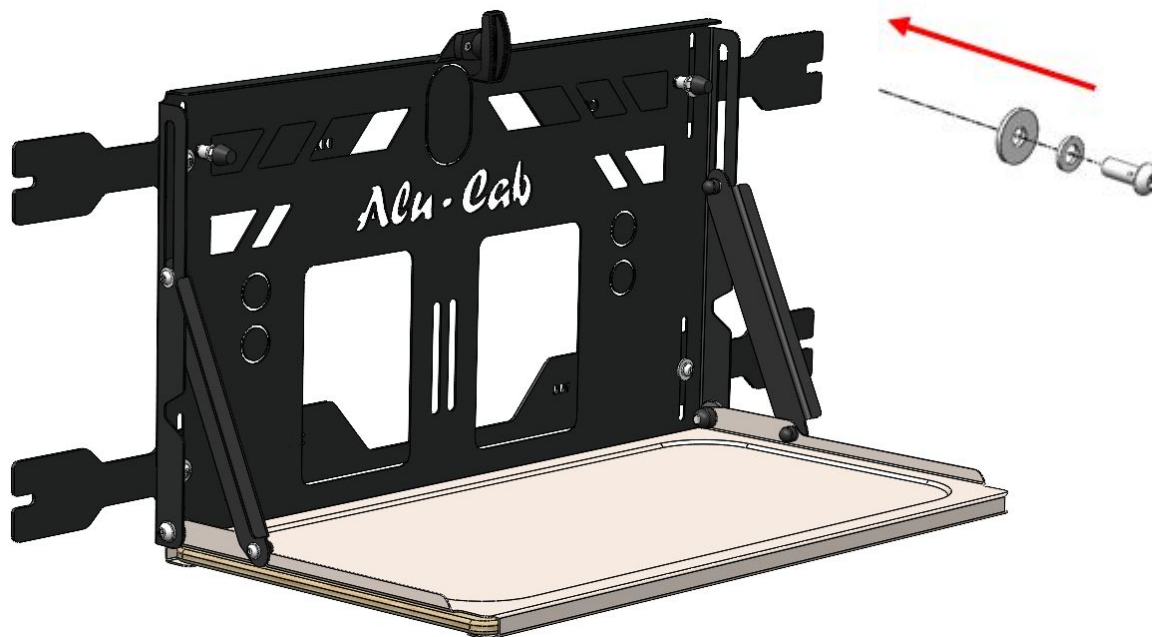
Drop down table to Canopy Camper rear door

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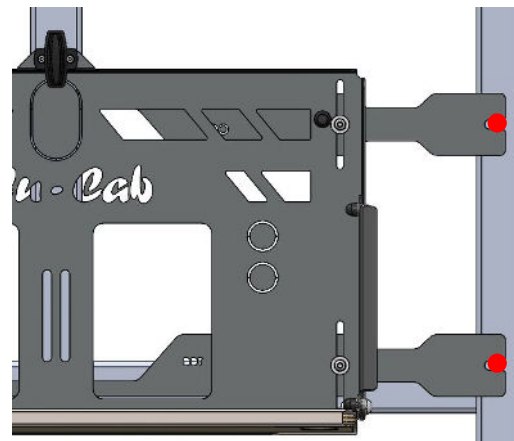
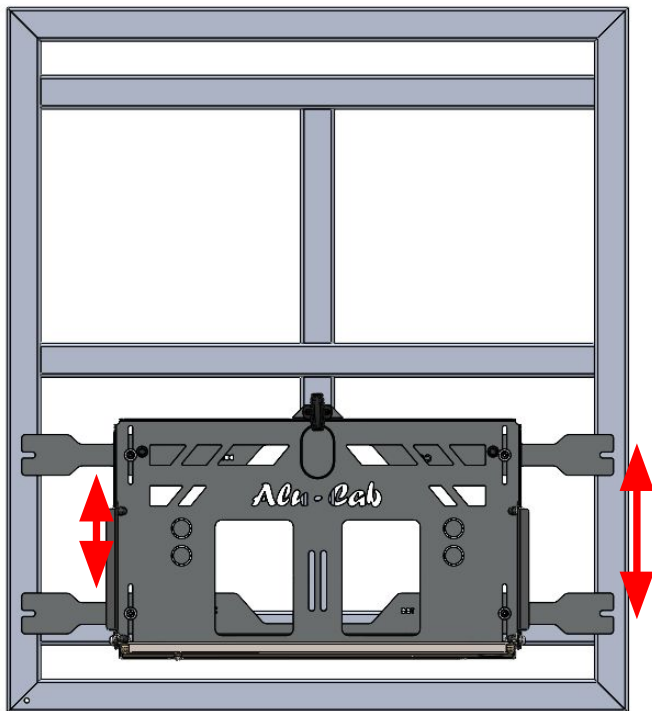
Loosely fasten the Drop-down Table to the two mounting plates using the steps in instruction number 5.



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Position the table and mounting plates at the desired height and location on the rear door of the Canopy camper.

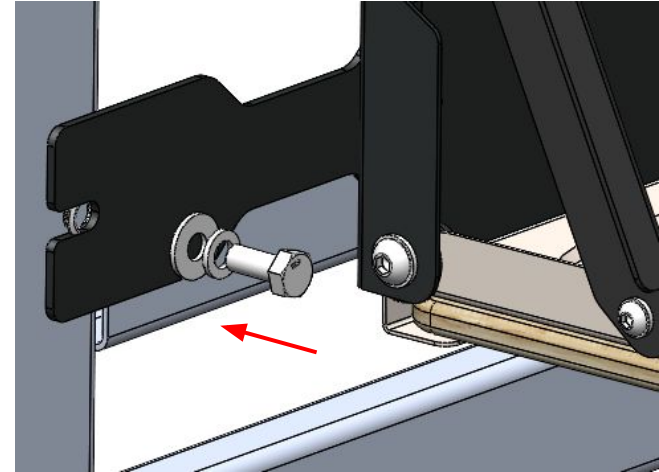
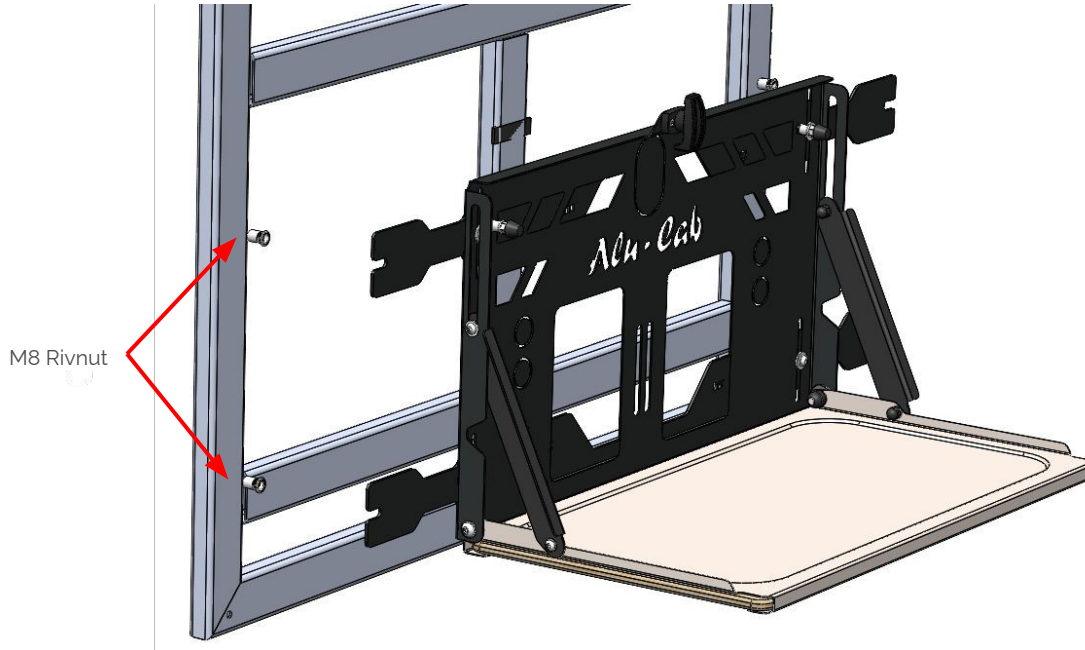


Mark the hole position for the M8 Rivnuts and using an 11mm drill bit, drill holes in the canopy camper door frame being careful to only drill through the single wall of the aluminum extrusion.

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Using a M8 Rivnut gun / tool, secure the Riv-nuts into the canopy campy door frame. Using the M8 Hex bolts, spring washers, and flat washers, fasten the mounting brackets to the door frame and after positioning it into place, fasten all the nuts and bolts tightly.
